Below are just a few examples of the services that are being provided:

- Jackson County United Way funds **128 programs through 20 agencies** serving over **42,000 residents** 365 days a year.
- Stuff The Bus collected over **\$11,000 of school supplies** for all county schools.
- **All Middle School students** in Jackson County are taught about substance abuse prevention by Girls Inc. through its friendly PEERsuasion classes.
- Over **200 individuals** received free assistance in electronic filing of their Federal and Indiana tax returns with **\$268,013 in Federal refunds** and **\$87,886 in Earned Income Credits**.
- FamilyWize Prescription Discount Drug cards has saved local residents **\$328,309**.
- The American Red Cross trained 20% more instructors.
- Over **850 students** in Jackson County received "Healthy Dating Relationships" program from Turning Point.
- Anchor House gave out food for **80,415 meals** last year.
- Boys & Girls Club have **1,051 members** enrolled in after school activities through Jackson county AmeriCorps afterschool coordinators at Brownstown, Crothersville and Medora.
- 71% of children mentored in the Big Brothers Big Sisters program last year improved academic performance
- Read Jackson County's 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Jackson County Book Drive received more than 5,600 donated books.
- 90% of students in Jackson County Successful Schools Family Preschool learned their ABC's.

## How Can My Gift Be Matched?

### MATCHING GRANT OPPORTUNITIES!

### Employee Campaigns

#### Employee Campaigns Increase by 10% or more

- The increase over last year's giving will be matched by the 1010 grant.

#### New Employee Campaigns

(companies that had no employee contributions during the 2010 campaign)

- The entire amount of the employee contributions will be matched dollar for dollar.

### Individual Leadership Giving

In order for an individual's gift to qualify for the 1010 grant matching dollars, one of the following must apply:

- New leadership gift, \$500 or more. (New money is matched)
- Leadership gift that moves up to the next club level. (Increase is matched)
- Leadership gift that increases by 10 % or more. (Increase is matched)
