WHAT A DIFFERENCE YOUR CONTRIBUTION MAKES

\$1 a week will provide:

- ❖ Breakfasts or snacks for a whole class of at risk kids for a week. *Head Start*
- ❖ An entire month's worth of educational supplies for a classroom. *Head Start*
- ❖ Learning opportunities for a preschooler to prepare him/her for kindergarten. *Family Preschool by Child Care Network*
- ❖ Clothing for a family of four for a whole year. *Anchor House*

\$2 a week will provide:

- ❖ Transportation for children of low-income families to and from a classroom for a week. *Head Start*
- ❖ A month of after-school activities for a school age child. Memberships for 10 girls from low-income families. *Girl Scouts*
- ❖ Nine hours of quality training for a volunteer leader. *Girl Scouts*
- ❖ A boy from a low-income family to participate in troop activities for a year. *Boy Scouts*
- ❖ Supplies for one week at one Kids Klub site. *Child Care Network*

\$3 a week will provide:

- ❖ Crisis intervention for a family escaping a violent home. *Turning Point*
- ❖ Eight pounds of food for needy families. *Anchor House*
- ❖ A week of summer camp for a needy boy. *Boy Scouts*

\$5 a week will provide:

- ❖ Full program benefits for a girl who might not otherwise be able to participate. *Girl Scouts*
- ❖ Cots and blankets for disaster victims in a shelter. *American Red Cross*
- ❖ A social evening for 80 clients. *Mental Health of America*

\$6 a week will provide:

- ❖ A family in crisis situation to be connected and resolve a problem with a loved one in the armed services. *American Red Cross*
- ❖ A whole day of 211 information and referral service that assists an average of 80 people/day in finding help with utilities, clothing, rent, food, shelter, unemployment, disabilities, and more. *First Call for Help 211*

\$7 a week will provide:

- ❖ A night of shelter for a mother and her two children. *Turning Point*
- ❖ Medical insurance for 7 members. *Boy Scouts*
- ❖ Utility assistance for one month for 5 families. *Salvation Army*
- ❖ Christmas gifts for 30 clients. *Mental Health of America*

\$10 a week will provide:

- ❖ Groceries for ten disaster victims. *American Red Cross*
- ❖ Clothing and shoes for a family of four whose home has burned. *American Red Cross*
- ❖ Membership for 1 girl for 1 year. *Girls Inc.*
- ❖ An hour of tutoring after school. *Boys & Girls Club*

\$15 a week will provide:

- ❖ Lunch for 5 children enrolled in the summer program. *Boys & Girls Club & Girls Inc.*
- ❖ Purchase a skill book & workbook for one student. *Read Jackson County*
- ❖ One half tank of gas for a resident needing transportation to work or the doctor. *Read Jackson County*

\$17 a week will provide:

- ❖ A child with a positive adult influence in his/her life for an entire school year. *Boys & Girls Club*
- ❖ A Christmas gift for a waiting list child. *Big Brothers/Sisters*
- ❖ Funding for the Special Olympics. *ARC*

\$20 a week will provide:

- ❖ Purchase school supplies for 10 "Littles". *Big Brothers/Sisters*
- ❖ Membership for 4 individuals. *ARC*
- ❖ One week of diapers for a child of a client. *Anchor House*
- ❖ Activities for seniors for one month. *Senior Citizens at Brownstown, Crothersville, Freetown, Medora & Seymour*

\$25 a week will provide:

- ❖ A whole year of hot meals delivered to a senior citizen. *Meals on Wheels*
- ❖ Two educational field trips for one girl. *Girls Inc.*
- ❖ Three hours a day of before & after-school supervised childcare to a working parent for 1 week. *Child Care Network*
- ❖ Laundry supplies. *Anchor House*
