- Took babysitting classes at Girls, Inc.; Red Cross taught the instructors.
- Were involved in one of many sporting programs provided by Boys & Girls Club.
- Attended a Boy Scout or Girl Scout activity.
- Attended 3<sup>rd</sup> grade in Jackson County; Girls, Inc. is in every school system providing “KidAbility” classes which talks about physical, emotional & sexual abuse prevention.
- Attended 4<sup>th</sup> grade in Jackson County; Red Cross is in every school teaching Basic Aid Training.
- Attended Middle School in Jackson County; Girls, Inc. provided “Friendly Peer-suasion” which is a substance abuse prevention program.
- Use licensed Day Care providers; the provider is taught CPR & First Aid by the Red Cross.
- Enrolled in the before and after school Kids Klub program in Seymour; this is provided by Child Care Network.
- Swim in Jackson County public pools and/or lakes; Red Cross trains all the lifeguards.
- Live or work in Jackson County – ALL the Jackson county fire departments, both city and volunteer workers, are trained in CPR and first aid by the Red Cross.
