Become a Volunteer Tax Preparer

Why volunteer?

Each year, millions of dollars go unclaimed when hard-working families in our area fail to claim their Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC). That money is lost to them and our local economy.

Additionally, many families use paid tax service firms and pay high preparation fees. With your help, Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) sites can prepare tax returns at no cost and offer e-filing for free.

By volunteering as a tax preparer, you can make a difference for families and help bring money back into our community.

- Free training offered on-line or by attending a class.
- Tax sites run from late January - March 2010.
- Time commitments are flexible.
