VITA Volunteers Needed

What: The Jackson County United Way (JCUW) Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program provides free tax preparation and asset development services to taxpayers with low to moderate income, non-English speaking persons, and individuals with disabilities.

Volunteers are needed to assist families prepare their taxes from late January through March. No accounting experience is required. Volunteers can dictate when they are available to help; will receive a free training offered on-line or by attending a class; and will be protected under the Volunteer Protection Act.

Volunteers are needed to help people prepare their tax returns in the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance program sponsored by the Jackson County United Way Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program. We are looking for volunteers to serve as Tax Preparers, Greeters, Site Coordinators, and Translators.

More information: Volunteer Tax Assistors provide free, basic income tax preparation services to community members with low-to-moderate incomes.

Volunteers also are needed to help in other ways. Some volunteers help organize tax sites, while others may do publicity for a site.
