Designating to an individual 501(c) (3) nonprofit organization: To be eligible to receive your gift, the agency must meet criteria based on 501(c) (3) not-for-profit status and compliance with the USA Patriot Act. If a chosen agency is ineligible, or your information is incomplete or illegible, we will make every reasonable effort to contact you. If we are unable to reach you, your contribution will go toward the general campaign fund. A 10% processing and fundraising fee will be withheld to cover uncollectable pledges and processing costs on designations.

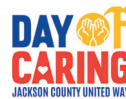
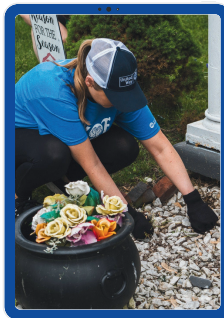
HOW YOUR GIFT CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE

Since 2023:



The free school supplies program; Rock'n Ready has served 3,575 students and helped families / caregivers save \$110,000 in back to school costs.



Day of Caring has helped residents, churches, and non-profits save over \$67,000 in project labor costs.



The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program has helped over 840 clients keep more than \$125,850.
