

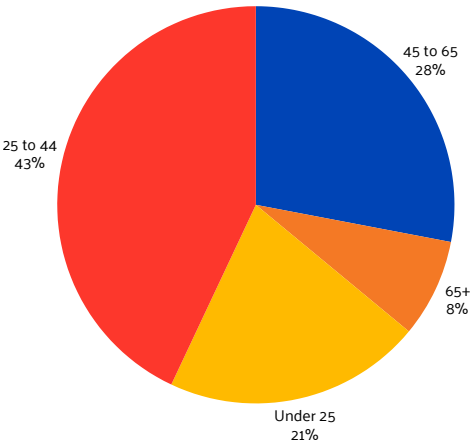
ALICE is an acronym for **A**sset **L**imited, **I**ncome **C**onstrained, and **E**mployed. These are households that earn more than the Federal Poverty Level, but less than the basic cost of living in Jackson County. Our **ALICE** neighbors are living paycheck to paycheck and barely getting by.

37% Of Jackson County households are considered ALICE or in poverty

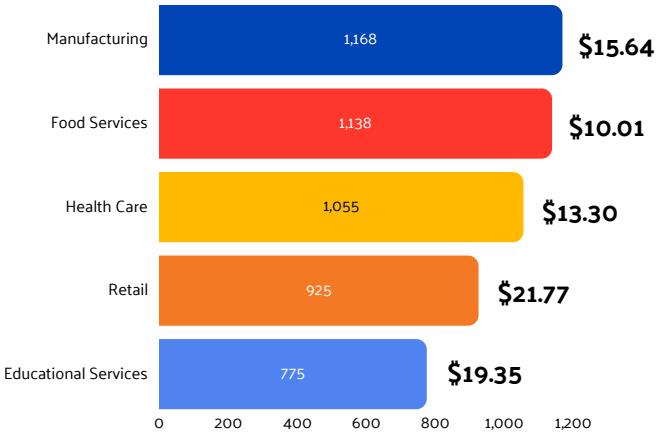
15% Of Jackson County ALICE households, are living in food insecurity

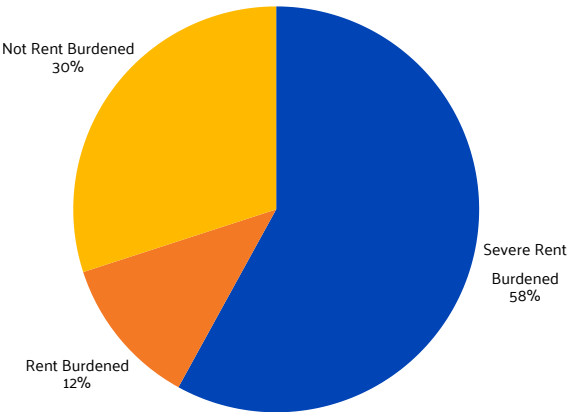

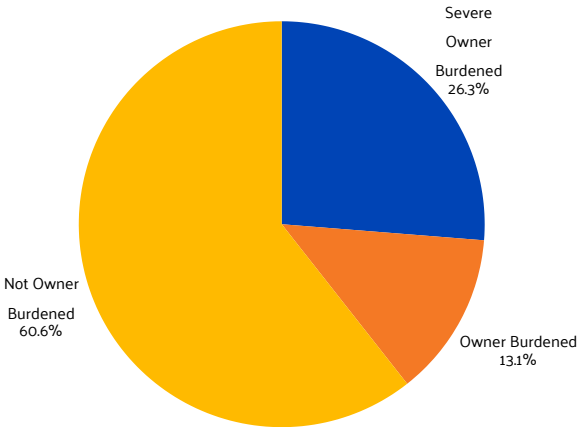

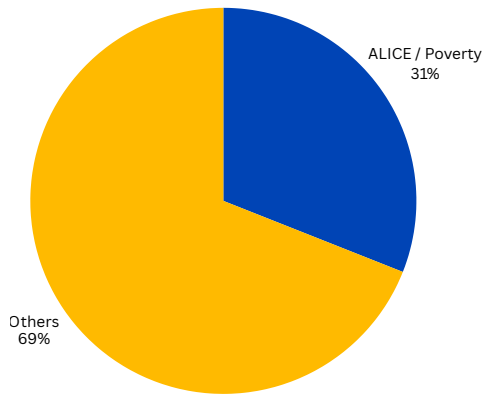

Rent Burden**



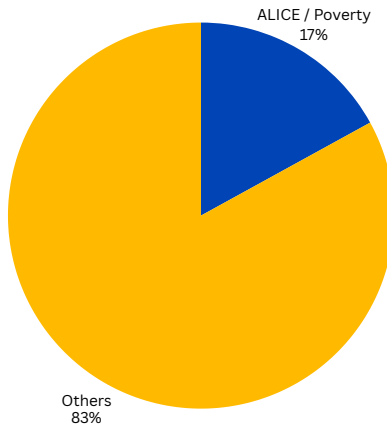
